
4 Reference Lists / Bibliographies

Whether you are using footnotes, endnotes or brief references in the text you must supply full information about the sources of information you are referring to. The information supplied about each publication must contain the following elements:


- the name of the author(s),
- the date of publication,
- the title of the work (also the name and issue number of the journal if it is from a journal, or the name of the collection and the editor if it is from an edited collection),
- the publisher
